HOW TO COMPLETE THE ST PAUL'S ADMISSIONS FORM for September 2008

The form is divided into four sections, and is structured in such a way so that the Governors can determine which category in our Admissions criteria to place each child in.

SECTION 1 (to be completed by all parents) gives details of the child, date of birth, address, current school, etc.

SECTION 2 (to be completed by all parents) states whether the child is a baptised/ baptised practising Catholic or not.

If the child is a baptised Catholic, then a copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate must be attached to the application. If the child is a baptised, practising Catholic, a copy of the child's First Holy Communion Certificate must also be attached.

SECTION 3 (to be completed only if the child is a baptised Catholic and regularly attends Mass in a Parish)

Please note this section **must** be countersigned by your Parish Priest.

SECTION 4 (to be completed only if the child is not a baptised Catholic but regularly attends a Church)

Please note, that if you complete this section then you must submit a letter of support from your Minister.

FINALLY It is important that the form is signed and dated by a parent or guardian either in Section 3, or on the back page, after Section 4.
